Why WOD 2018

- According to WWF, three-quarters of the world's coral reefs are now threatened due to global warming.
- Project Seagrass estimates we are losing one hectare of seagrass every hour, important for carbon absorption and fisheries.
- ➤ Malaysia is the 8th top plastic polluter in the world. According to the United Nations, up to 90% of marine debris is made up of plastic polymers.
- We have also noticed the alarming rate with which plastics wash up to our beaches.
- Plastic micro-particles are also finding their way into our drinking water.









Event Objectives

Raise awareness about the issues affecting the ocean's health and the importance of coral reefs, seagrass and sharks. Get everyone to appreciate the beauty of the oceans and how we are linked to it.

Encourage one and all to get involved in the prevention of marine litter by educating them and providing alternative solutions. A special focus is plastic pollution.




